


<p>Unsafe Condition Identified</p>	<p>Unauthorized activities with paragliders over the military bases as reported to the Kosovo CAA</p>
<p>Required action(s), their rationale and compliance time(s)</p>	<p>All the paragliding activities may be conducted only within operationally approved paragliding zones published in the Aeronautical Information Publication (AIP) of the Republic of Kosovo.</p> <p>The requests for the paragliding activities shall be submitted not less than 3 working days in advance. Such request shall be submitted to AIS, which will share the information to CAA and KFOR, for approvals.</p> <p>In cases of a special events, paragliding activities planned to be conducted outside of the approved paragliding zones, shall be subject to prior authorization by KFOR and CAA and subsequent notifications sent to the relevant authorities (Kosovo Police and</p>

	<p>KANS). The request for such operations shall be submitted at least five (5) working days in advance.</p> <p>Any person found in violation of the provisions of this Safety Directive, shall be issued a penalty in accordance with Article 96 and/or 97 of the Law No. 03/L-051 on Civil Aviation, as amended.</p>
